- Don't plant until Mother's Day!
 - While the sun is warm and inviting, it's a bit early to plant flowering annuals.
 - It's a great time to trim and prune before sap begins to rise. Clear the area around your azaleas and hibiscus.
 - Magnesium and iron will produce greener leaves and blooms. Scatter 12-12-12 fertilizer in flower and vegetable growing area. Palm trees love 12-6-1 fertilizer.
